Personality Sketches

DR. JESSE M. BADER



Dr. Jesse M. Bader is the person who started these Christian Missions throughout America in 1936. He has done such a fine job ever since that he still holds the distinctive position of Secretary of the Department of

Evangelism of the Federal Council of Churches.

He is also a great preacher as well as a superb administrative head. He is responsible for the fine choice of speakers for this Mission. His department plans to sponsor similar meetings in the other ten relocation centers. We are indeed very grateful for his great interest in us.

REV. JOHN E. COBB



Rev. John B. Cobb was a missionary of the Southern Methodist Church to Japan (1918). As an evangelistic missionary he carried large responsibilities, having been superintendent of the Hiroshima district and

later of the Kobe district. Rev. Cobb's outstanding work has been in the field of popular education in Japan through English Night Schools and other social institutions.

He was at one time Treasurer and Business Manager of the Mission, and has served on many important commissions in the Japan Methodist Church. Upon his return, he immediately took up work among persons of Japanese ancestry living in the United States. He has since 1941 been pastor of the Methodist work and director of church activities among the Japanese in Spokane, Wash., and the neighborhood.

MRS. JESSIE B. EUBANK

Mrs. Jessie Burrall Eubank is one of the few women in this country who has distinguished herself as a writer and lecturer. Her affiliations are member of the Religious Educational Association, American As-



sociation of University Women, P.E.O., and the Order Eastern Star.

The enviable positions she has held are member of the editorial staff of the National Geographic Magazine; founder and teacher of a Bible class of 1800 members in Washington, D.C., 1917-21; professor and head of Department of Religious Education at Stephens College, Columbia, Mo. She was a lecturer in education at the University of Cincinnati and member of the Baptist World Commission on Marriage and Home and also Vice President of the Northern Baptist Convention.

DR. E. STANLEY JONES

Dr. E. Stanley Jones is one of the top Christian leaders of his age. His name ranks with such great men as Dr. Toyohiko Kagawa and Dr. Albert Schweitzer. Dr. Jones has given many years of his life to India



as a missionary. Every message he gives is vital to all who deem it worthwhile to live and to die for the Kingdom of God.

Translated into nearly all the languages of the world, his books and lectures have reached countless millions. Some of them are "The Christ of the Indian Road," "The Christ of the Mount," "Victorious Living," "Is the Kingdom of God Realism?" and his latest book off the press last December, "Abundant Living," has reached its 200,000th sale. Everyone should own a copy of this great book.

DR. ALBERT P. SHIRKEY



Dr. Albert P. Shirkey is the pastor of one of the largest churches in the United States, namely, the Travis Park Methodist Church in the heart of San Antonio, Texas. It has a membership of 4200 and has been served

by four bishops in the past. He has held pastorates in Richmond, Va., and in Washington, D.C.

He is one of the truly great speakers of our time and especially sought after by the young people. Dr. Shirkey was for five years Vesper Speaker for the Young People's Assembly in Virginia and for two years the Platform Speaker for the Young People's Assembly of the Baltimore Conference. This year Dr. Shirkey was the platform speaker at the Pastor's School at Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas.

MISS JESSIE TROUT

Miss Jessie Trout is an author and former missionary to Japan. She is the associate director of the "Emergency Million for Life and Work," a nation-wide campaign being conducted by the Disciples of Christ.



Formerly, she was secretary to Dr. Toyohiko Kagawa. In 1921 Miss Trout went to Japan as a missionary under the auspices of the United Christian Missionary Society of Disciples of Christ.

In Akita, Japan, she was supervisor of the kindergarten and did some evangelistic work. Later she went to Tokyo as a teacher in the Margaret K. Long Girls' School. In addition she had charge of the religious activities of the school and was prominent in club and civic work in Tokyo. She is very fluent in Japanese.

WHO'S WHO ON THE TEAM



MISS JESSIE TROUT, author and former missionary to Japan, is associate director of the "Emergency Million for Life and Work", a nation-wide campaign which is being conducted by Disciples of Christ. She was the personal secretary to Dr. T. Kagawa, world known philosopher and social worker of Japan. In 1921 Miss Trout went to Japan as a missionary of the Disciples of Christ denomination. As a supervisor and a teacher, she has done great evangelistic and guidance work. She is unusually fluent in her use of Japanese; she was an exceptional teacher. 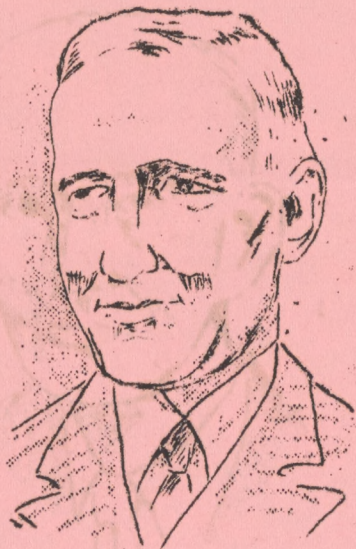


REV. JOHN B. COBB went to Japan as a missionary of the Southern Methodist Church in the year 1918, and he served till 1941 when the missionaries were withdrawn. As an evangelistic missionary he carried huge responsibilities, supervising the Hiroshima District, & later the Kobe District, which is the largest area of work done by that Mission. He has been outstanding in the field of popular education in Japan, where he worked through English Night Schools and other social institutions. He directed the Fraser Institute, Hiroshima; was Principal of Palmore Institute of Kobe; and was Principal of the Osaka English School, conducted by the Methodist Mission. He was at one time Treasurer and Business Manager of the Mission, and has served on many important commissions in the Japan Methodist Church. Upon his return, Rev. Cobb immediately took up work among the persons of Japanese ancestry living in the United States. He has since been pastor of the Methodist work and the director of the church activities of the Japanese in Spokane, Washington and the adjacent districts.



DR. JESSE M. BADER was the man who began the Christian Mission in 1936. He has done such a remarkable work since the inception of the Mission that he continues to hold the responsible position of Secretary of the Department of Evangelism of the Federal Council of Churches. Besides being a great administrator, he is a great preacher as well. It is he, who is responsible for the fine choice of speakers which we have for the Jerome Christian Mission. We are, indeed, indebted to him for this great Christian uplift which we shall experience during the Mission.

DR. E. STANLEY JONES is one of the foremost Christian leaders of this age. His fame ranks with such great men as Dr. T. Kagawa and Dr. A. Schweitzer. MRS. JESSIE EURAL EUBANK is one of the few women in this country who has distinguished herself as a writer and lecturer. She will come to us from her home in Cincinnati, Ohio. Her affiliations are Member of the Religious Educational Association, American Association of University Women, Order of Eastern Star, and the P.E.O. The enviable positions which she has held in the past are Member of Editorial Staff, National Geographic Magazine; Chief of School Service, National Geographic Society, 1915-21; founder and teacher of Bible class of 1800 members in Washington D.C., 1917-21; Professor and Head of the Department of Religious Education, University of Cincinnati; Member of the Baptist World Committee on MARRIAGE AND THE HOME; and Vice-President of the Northern Baptist Convention, 1935-36.



DR. ALBERT P. SHIRKEY is the pastor of one of the largest churches in the United States: namely, the Travis Park Methodist Church in the heart of San Antonio, Texas. This church has a membership of 4,300 and has been served by four bishops in the past. He has held pastorates in Richmond, Va., and in Washington, D.C. 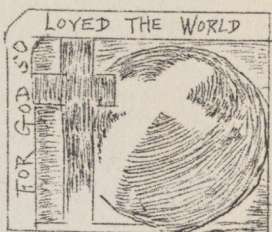
