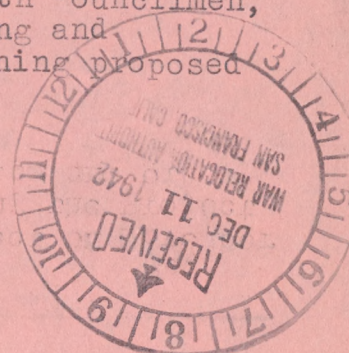

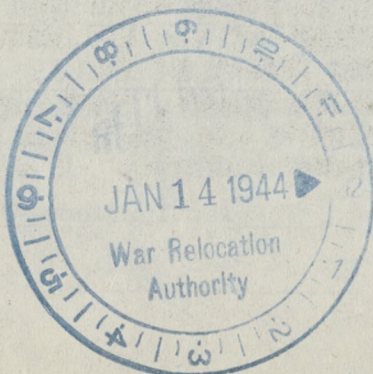

REPORT OF PROJECT ATTORNEY
James H. Terry

During the first week of November, 1943, I was engaged primarily in preparation for my trip to Washington and was preparing data and reports to the Solicitor relating to the work of the Evacuee Property Division and its Field Offices on the West Coast. On November 7th, I left the Center for Washington and returned on the morning of December 11th. During my absence, this office was in charge of my assistant, Mr. Joseph Omachi. He performed legal services for evacuee residents and handled a considerable number of cases, but no record of the exact number has been kept. He assisted the Evacuee Property Officer in answering legal questions connected with evacuee property work when called upon to do so. He corresponded with the Evacuee Property Division Field Offices and various individuals and concerns in California with respect to evacuee legal matters.

During my stay in Washington of slightly over two weeks, I conferred with the Solicitor and his assistants; on frequent occasions, prepared various memoranda and case lists taking up a number of Project legal matters and communicated with the Project with regard thereto; conferred with representatives of most of the Divisions of the War Relocation Authority in Washington on matters relating to the operation of the Gila River Center. Included in these conferences was a conference with Mr. Buttedahl of the Reports Office in which I explained the fact that the present status of the lack of staff here was such that it is extremely difficult to catalog, classify and number each request for advice and consultation which we receive from evacuees and the Evacuee Property Officer. I advised him that consequently my reports would depart from the form, in that number of cases of various classifications would not be recited. In direct contact with the Relocation Offices in New York, Boston, Chicago and Philadelphia. In the New York, Boston and Chicago Offices, I was consulted on various legal matters, some pertaining to the Gila River Center and some of a general nature. I also discussed various phases of the relocation program as affecting this Center.

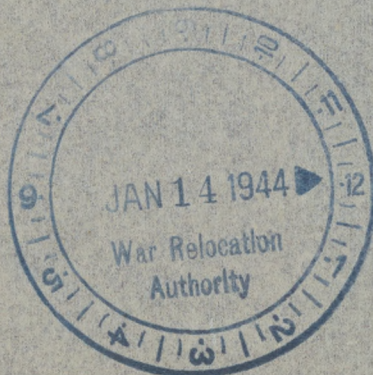
Since returning to the Center on December 11th, I have continued my work with the Community Councils, attending various meetings and consulting with representatives of the Council. I have attended meetings of the Policy Committee with the Project Director. I have attended meetings of the Relocation Committee and am serving on the Executive Board of that Committee. I am also serving on the Health Board, serving as co-chairman of the Leave Clearance Committee and chairman of the Review Committee of all leave clearance dockets. I have

conferred with officials of the administration here on a wide variety of legal questions relating to the administration. I have conferred with and aided the Consumer's Cooperative and the Community Enterprises, particularly with respect to restrictions of the Arizona Statute, known as Chapter 89 of the Session Laws of 1943,* and with respect to arrangements for the sale of fire insurance coverage at this Center. I have attended a number of project trials and conferred with the representatives of the newly established Judicial Commission. From December 18th to 23rd, I was in the project hospital, and since that time, have been under medical care to an extent which does not interfere greatly with my daily work. I have conferred with Mr. Provinse and various other representatives of the Washington Office who have visited the project during the month of December, and have made arrangements, too, in preparation for the Property Conference in San Francisco during January. I have, of course, communicated on considerable number of occasions with the Solicitor.

Consultations with various officials outside of WRA, including G2, ONI, FBI, Attorney General's Office, Arizona State officials, etc. are not included in the above report.
