- 1. Cal-OSHA (SB 1215-Escutia)** Would have required the governor's Cal-OSHA Board appointments to be confirmed by the Senate and to leave their post within 60 days of the end of their term. Passed 49-29, September 13, 2001. **Vetoed**
- 2. Civil Rights (AB 1015-Wright)** Extends employee anti-discrimination laws to applicants for employment and prohibits discrimination regarding lawful conduct outside of employment. Passed 50-21, May 24, 2001. **Signed**
- 3. Consumers (AB 313-Goldberg)** Permits WIC coupons to be redeemed at any authorized vendor and provides for information to be printed in a form readable to new scanning technology. Passed 68-5, June 5, 2001. **Signed**
- 4. Faculty Part-Timers (AB 1245-Alquist)** Requires that reappointment rights for specified community college part-time faculty be a mandatory subject of negotiation. Passed 52-14, May 17, 2001. **Signed**
- 5. Farm Labor (AB 1680-Labor & Employment Committee)** Would have required that farm labor contractor license classes be conducted by the Labor Commissioner. Passed 49-23, May 17, 2001. **Vetoed**
- 6. Health Care (AB 1075-Shelley)** Requires regulations to be set for safe staff-to-patient ratios for direct caregivers working in skilled nursing facilities. Passed 47-24, June 6, 2001. **Signed**
- 7. Immigrants' Rights (AB 60-Cedillo)** Would allow for a taxpayer identification number to be used in lieu of a Social Security number for purposes of applying for a driver's license. Passed 53-20, June 7, 2001. **Two-year bill**
- 8. Janitor Job Stability (SB 20-Alarcon)** Permits janitors to keep their jobs with a successor maintenance contractor up to 60 days when their employer has lost a janitorial contract. Passed 46-28, September 5, 2001. **Signed**
- 9. Labor Agency (SB 25-Alarcon)** Would have created a state Labor and Civil Rights Agency consisting of labor-related agencies (DIR, EDD, DFEH, FEHC, PERB, and ALRB). Passed 50-27, September 10, 2001. **Vetoed**
- 10. Prevailing Wage (SB 975-Alarcon)** Expands coverage of prevailing wage laws to projects funded through the California Infrastructure and Economic Development Bank. Passed 51-29, September 4, 2001. **Signed**
- 11. Public Employees (AB 1281-Cedillo)** Card check recognition for local agency public employees. Passed 47-22, May 10, 2001. **Signed**
- 12. Sick Leave (SB 1197-Romero)** Would have provided that employers not use 'absence control' policies to discipline workers or deny them their right to family sick leave afforded by AB 109 [1999]. Passed 48-28, September 5, 2001. **Vetoed**
- 13. Social Security (SJR 8-Speier)** Expresses the opposition of the Legislature to privatization of the Social Security system. Passed 47-26, August 23, 2001. **Adopted**
- 14. Temporary Labor Force (AB 1679-Shelley)** Would have created an employer of record when an employee is supplied by a tempo-

rary agency to an employer utilizing a contractors' license. Passed 49-19, May 24, 2001. **Vetoed**

- 15. Trade Impact on Workers** (SB 1044-Kuehl) Would have provided for the Department of Industrial Relations to assess the impact of international trade agreements on California labor law. Passed 50-27, September 10, 2001. **Vetoed**
- 16. Unemployment Insurance** (SB 40-Alarcon) Raises Unemployment Insurance benefits, qualifies some part-time workers for benefits, and makes other changes to UI system. Passed 50-30, September 14, 2001. **Signed**
- 17. Workers' Compensation** (SB 71-Burton) Would have increased Workers' Compensation benefits and reformed the administration of the Workers' Compensation system. Passed 50-29, September 5, 2001. **Vetoed**

15. Trade Impact on Workers (SB 1044-Kuehl) Would have provided for the Department of Industrial Relations to assess the impact of international trade agreements on California labor law. Passed 23-15, May 30, 2001. **Vetoed**

16. Unemployment Insurance (SB 40-Alarcon) Raises Unemploy-

ment Insurance benefits, qualifies some part-time workers for benefits, and makes other changes to UI system. Passed 24-14 June 6, 2001. **Signed**

17. Wage and Hour Protections (SB 278-Alarcon) Would establish a cause of action for a commercial driver against a motor carrier who requires the driver to operate a vehicle in excess of the maximum number of hours permitted under law. Passed 22-11, April 19, 2001. **Two-year bill**

18. Workers' Compensation (SB 71-Burton) Would have increased Workers' Compensation benefits and

reformed the administration of the Workers' Compensation system. Passed 24-14, May 14, 2001. **Vetoed**

19. Workers' Rights (AB 1025-Frommer) Provides reasonable unpaid break time and accommodations for employees to express breast milk for the employee's infant child. Passed 25-9, August 27, 2001. **Signed**

20. Workers' Rights (SB 871-Burton) Ensures drug and alcohol screening laws relating to commercial carriers are adhered to and make carriers responsible when laws are not followed. Passed 28-9, May 21, 2001. **Signed**
