Mr. Robertson hails from Berkeley, California, and graduated from the University of Utah and from Georgetown University in Washington, D.C. He was recently appointed the Secretary of Labor's Personal Regional Representative for the Western States. He has worked for the Department of Labor for 26 years; in 1948 he was assigned to San Francisco as regional attorney, and in 1963 he was appointed the Secretary's regional representative in Washington, D.C.
