Topic: Labor Today and Tomorrow!!

It is with great pleasure that we present Mr. Fields as our next speaker at the forthcoming meeting of the IIR Alumni Association.

Mr. Fields was born in San Francisco, California, where he attended Lowell High School. After graduation from the University of California at Berkeley, he did graduate work in public administration at the University of California, the Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs of Syracuse University, and at Columbia University in New York. In addition, he received the LL.B. from George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Fields has had a long and distinguished career in labor relations, both in his home state and in the nation's capital. During the thirties he held positions as director of state unemployment relief in Plumas County, California, as labor coordinator for the WPA in ten northern California counties, and as manager of a migratory labor camp in Marysville. He joined the staff of the National Labor Relations Board in 1941, working as field examiner in Chicago and Seattle, and as administrative examiner in Washington, D.C., from 1944 to 1948. Mr. Fields was appointed Assistant Executive Secretary in 1948, and Executive Secretary in March, 1960. The Fields and their three children live in Silver Springs, Maryland.
