Mr. Bakaly, a graduate of Stanford University, received his law degree from the University of Southern California and was admitted to practice before the California State Supreme Court, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, the U.S. Court of Military Appeals, and the U.S. Supreme Court. He has been a member of the law firm of O'Melveny & Myers since 1963, specializing in labor relations law and collective bargaining. He has lectured extensively on arbitration issues and has written a number of articles including "An Employer's Rights in a National Labor Relations Board Representation Election" (Los Angeles Bar Bulletin, February, 1963), "And After AVCO" (Labor Law Journal, February, 1969), and "Decisions Affecting the Networks and Unions," to be published in a book entitled "Broadcasting and Bargaining." Mr. Bakaly is a member of the Los Angeles County Bar Association and of the American Bar Association. He is also Co-chairman of that Association's Committee on Practice and Procedure Under the National Labor Relations Act.
