

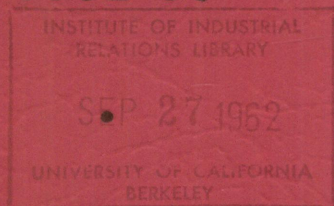

EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION

Article II, Section 1 — The purposes for which the Academy is formed are: To establish and foster the highest standards of integrity, competence, honor, and character among those engaged in the arbitration of industrial disputes on a professional basis; to adopt and encourage the acceptance of and adherence to canons of ethics to govern the conduct of arbitrators; to promote the study and understanding of the arbitration of industrial disputes; to encourage friendly association among the members of the profession; to co-operate with other organizations, institutions, and learned societies interested in industrial relations; and to do any and all things which shall be appropriate in the furtherance of these purposes.

Article V, Section 1 — Members shall be elected by the Board of Governors in the manner provided in the By-Laws.

STATEMENT OF ACADEMY PURPOSES AND AIMS

The National Academy of Arbitrators was founded at Chicago on September 13, 1947. As of January, 1962, the membership roster totaled approximately 300. The principal purposes of the organization are as follows:

"to establish and foster high standards and competence among those engaged in the arbitration of industrial disputes on a professional basis: to adopt canons of

ethics to govern the conduct of arbitrators: to promote the study and understanding of the arbitration of industrial disputes."

The Academy is not an agency for the selection or appointment of arbitrators. It does invite and sponsor activities designed to improve general understanding of the nature of arbitration and its use as a means of settling labor disputes. It meets in national conventions annually, and more often in regional groupings. Such meetings are from time to time, open to non-members.

The Academy maintains standing committees on Ethics, Research and Education, Legislation and Membership. The "Code of Ethics and Procedural Standards," jointly promulgated by the Academy and the American Arbitration Association, is the subject of continuing study and interpretive opinions by the Ethics Committee.

The Academy reprints for its members, lectures on various aspects of arbitration delivered at its meetings. A membership "Newsletter" devoted to internal organizational matters is circulated several times each year. The Academy publishes yearly a volume containing the proceedings of its annual meetings. A list of these publications is set forth on the back page of this directory.

The business affairs of the Academy are conducted through the Office of the Secretary, the present location of which is 1130 First National Bldg., Detroit 26, Mich.

NATIONAL ACADEMY OF ARBITRATORS STATEMENT OF POLICY RELATIVE TO MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS

Membership in the National Academy of Arbitrators is conferred by vote of the Board of Governors upon recommendation of the Membership Committee of the Academy. In considering applications for membership, the Academy will apply the following standards: (1) The applicant should be of good moral character, as demonstrated by adherence to sound ethical standards in professional activities. (2A) The applicant should have substantial and current experience as an impartial arbitrator of labor-management disputes, or (2B) in the alternative the applicant with limited but current experience in arbitration should have attained general recognition through scholarly publication or other activities as an impartial authority on labor-management relations. In evaluating the applicant's experience, the Academy will take into account his general acceptability to the parties. (3) Membership will not be conferred upon applicants primarily identified as advocates or consultants for Labor or Management in labor-management relations.* The application of the requirements of this resolution in particular cases is within the discretion of the Membership Committee, subject to review by the Board of Governors.

*Added January, 1956. Members admitted prior thereto were not subject to requirement (3).
