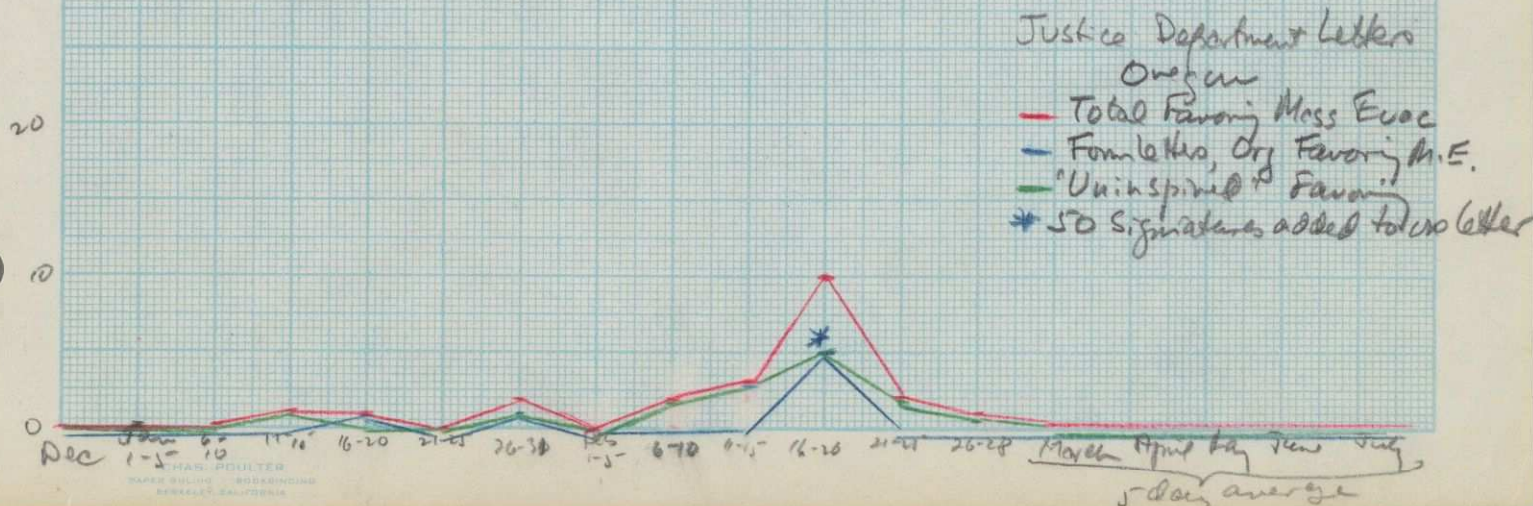
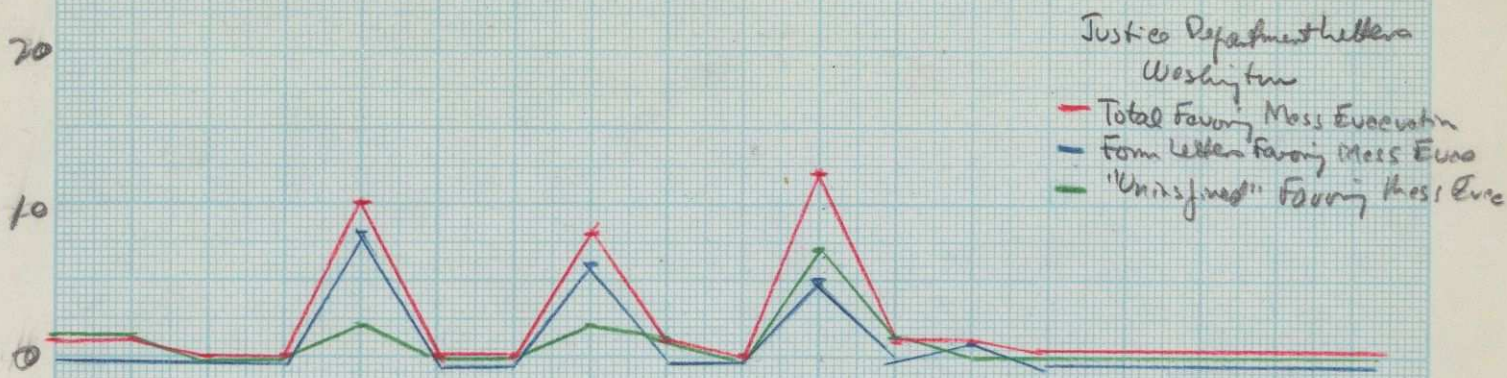
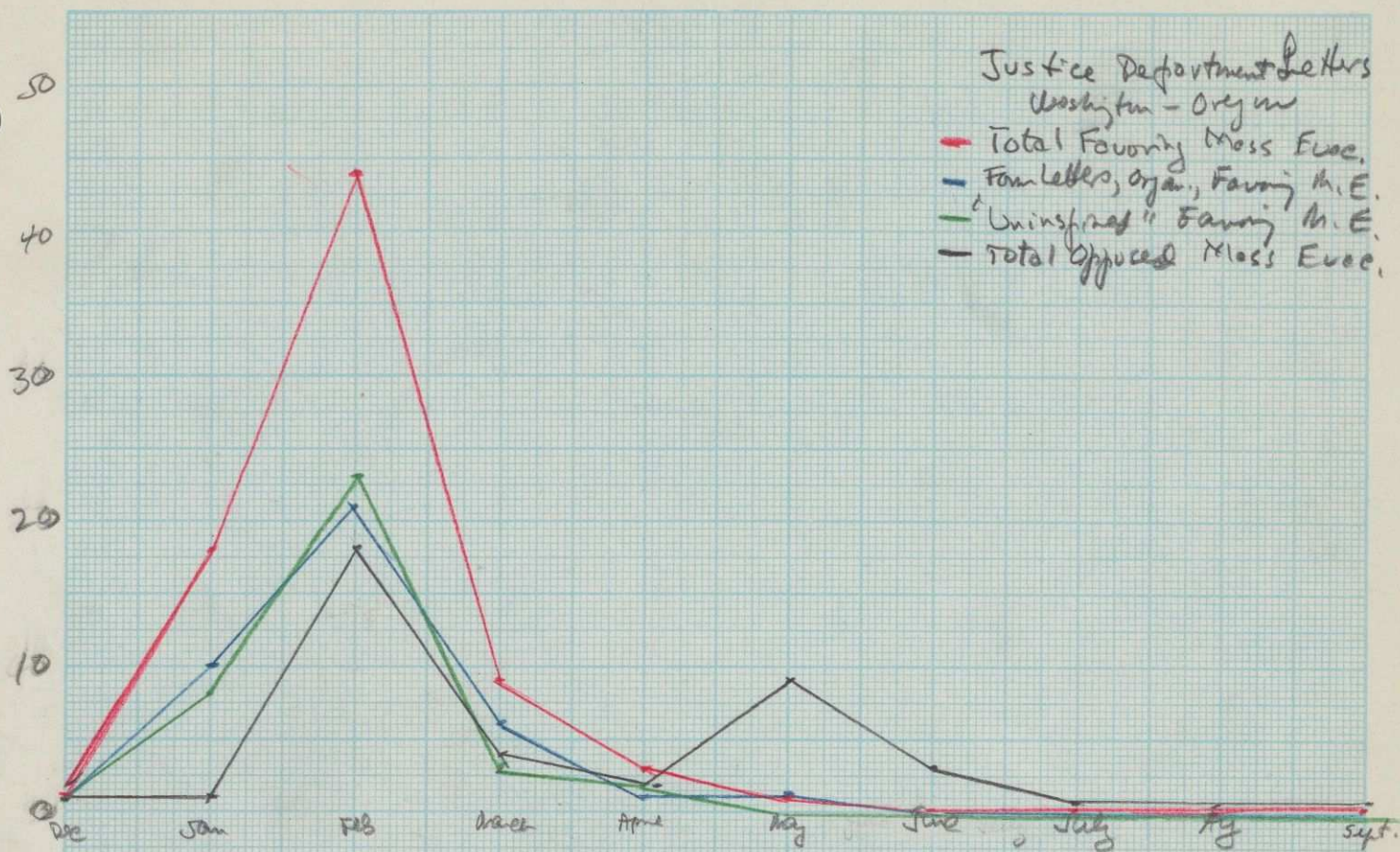


CHART TWO: TOTAL JUSTICE DEPARTMENT LETTERS

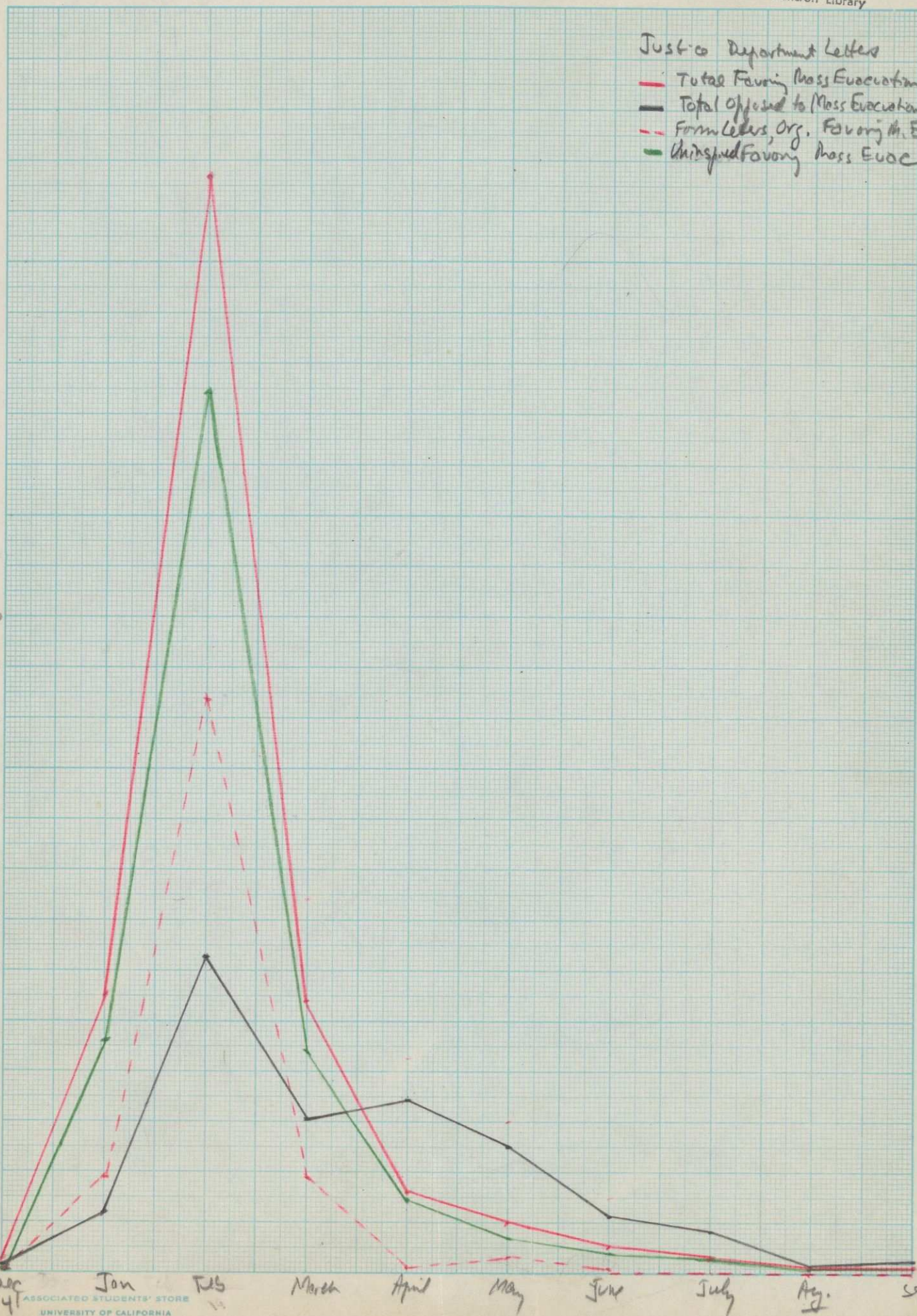

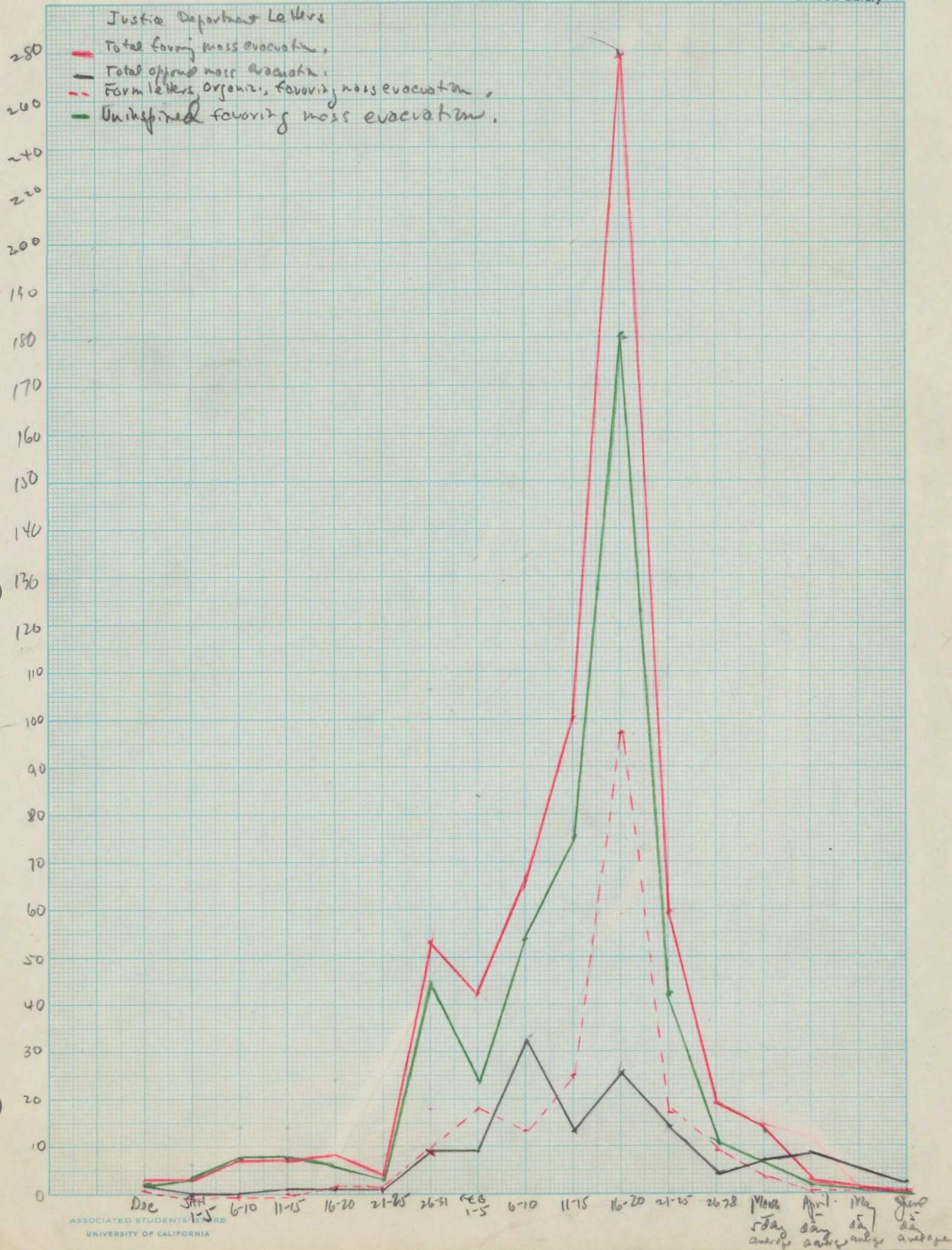
