**WITH THE FIFTH ARMY,
ITALY-- Pfc. Kiyoto
Ihara, whose mother formerly
lived in Fresno,
California, recently
was awarded the Bronze
Star for meritorious
service in combat.**

Member of the 442nd
Japanese American Com-
bat Team, Ihara was de-
corated by Maj. Gen.
Edward M. Almond, com-
mander of the Fifth Ar-
my's 92nd "Buffalo" Di-
vision, at a ceremony
in Novi, Italy.

He was cited for ac-
tion in the vicinity
of La Houssiere, France.

The citation read in
part:

"When radio and wire
communications between
platoons was disrupted
by enemy action and ad-
verse weather conditions,
Private Ihara repeated-
ly delivered messages
through artillery and
small arms fire. When
the platoon's ammuni-
tion supply was deplet-
ed, he voluntarily dis-
tributed ammunition and
alleviated the situation.

"Private Ihara res-
sured communication be-
tween the battalion
command post and his
company on two occasion
when the line was se-
vered by enemy action.
His courage and devo-
tion to duty are exem-
plary and a credit to
the U. S. Army."

In addition to the
Bronze Star, Ihara wears
the Combat Infantryman
Badge, the Good Con-
duct Medal and European
Theater Ribbon with
four battle stars.
