Series 4. Youth Organizations Founded by Michael Nulty, 1979-1999.

Physical Description: Carton 2-4; Carton 5, Folders 1-22; Carton 8; Oversize Box 1

Scope and Content Note: Consists of materials related to groups for sexual minority youth founded or led by Nulty. Researchers should note that there is a lot of overlap between groups and projects. When possible, Nulty's original folder titles have been retained. Includes administrative records, such as by-laws; correspondence; descriptions of each organization (by Nulty); documents regarding legal disputes; materials related to classified advertisements placed in *We Are Here*; publicity; statistics; and surveys. The bulk of the correspondence comes from the United States and consists of membership inquiries, requests for publications and mass mailings from other LGBT organizations. There are some more substantive letters from queer youth and mail from other countries, including Canada, France, Malaysia, Norway and South Africa. Nulty produced various publications (each with a unique number) that could be ordered by mail; these are included here. This series also contains Nulty's work on behalf of youth for the Gay Freedom Day Parade and for LGBT youth conferences.
