## **Biography/Administrative History**

Pomo Afro Homos is short for postmodern African American homosexuals. It was an African-American gay theater troupe founded in San Francisco by Djola Bernard Branner, Brian Freeman, and Eric Gupton. Later, Marvin K. White joined the group. The original concept of the group was to show the issues affecting each black gay person. Their pieces include *Fierce Love: Stories From Black Gay Life* and *Dark Fruit*. They performed nationally from Alaska to New York's Lincoln

Center. They faced opposition from the National Black Theatre Festival in North Carolina (1991), and later, in Anchorage (1993). They performed regularly between 1990 and 1995.

### **Scope and Content of Collection**

The records contain correspondence, programs, press releases and press coverage, contracts, scripts, financial information, photographs, slides, audiotapes, grant writing for Pomo Afro. The collection also contains certificates and awards presented to the troupe. Of particular note are the scripts for *Fierce Love: Stories from Black Gay Life* and *Dark Fruit*. The clippings files also include coverage of the opposition the group faced in Anchorage, Alaska, and North Carolina.
