Unidentified surgical instruments in wooden box. One saw with black handle, one small silver saw, three knives, one wire cutter-like nipper.

Unidentified surgical instruments in wooden box; several missing. Box labeled "U.S.A. Hosp. Dep. "

Unidentified surgical instruments, circa "Cival [sic] War", in wooden box with black cardboard cover. Some missing. Contains letter with some historical information.

Unidentified surgical instruments received in a wooden display case [case discarded].

Miscellaneous surgical instruments received in a large wooden box [box discarded] labeled "J.W. Wenkle".
