Biographical Note:

A local resident of Palm Springs, Harold E. "Buzz" Waltz (born 1943) owned and operated the family business, Harold E. Waltz, Photographs and Blueprinting from 1962 to 2012. He provided both commercial photography as well as a complete plan duplicating service for architects and customers.

He studied design and architecture at College of the Desert and is the recipient of awards from the Professional Photographers of America and Professional Photography West. But after the senior Waltz' death in 1962, he assumed the successful business and continued its growth.

Scope and Content Note:

The materials were donated by Harold E. “Buzz” Waltz in two parts (S2014.2, S2017.6) and contains one series – 65 Photographs and 243 negatives for a total of 308 items.

The photographs and negatives include primarily views of Palm Springs architecture, buildings both extant and demolished. These include Palm Springs International Airport, Merrill Lynch building, both designed by Don Wexler and Palm Springs Municipal Golf Club House designed by Kaptur and Lapham and also includes the Bullocks Building before demolition.
