### Biographical Note

Date	Event
March 7 <sup>th</sup> , 1885	Born Emil Oblasser in Portland Oregon.
1901-1908	Taking the religious name of Bonaventure, he entered the Order of Friars Minor (the Franciscans) and studied at Old Mission Santa Bárbara in Santa Bárbara during this time.
June 28 <sup>th</sup> , 1908	Ordained to the priesthood.
1908-1910	Served as assistant pastor at St. Elizabeth parish in Oakland California.
1910-1911	Served as a missionary at St. John's Mission and Indian School in Komatke, Arizona.
1913-1916	Served as a missionary at Mission San Xavier del Bac in Tucson, Arizona.
1916-1922	Served as a missionary at Old San Solano Mission in Cababi, Arizona.
1922-1939	Served as a missionary at New San Solano Mission in Topowa, Arizona.
1939-1941	Served at Old Mission San Luis Rey in Oceanside, California.
1941-1948	Served as a missionary at Santa Ysabel Asistencia in Santa Ysabel, California.
1949-1950	Served as assistant pastor at Old Mission San Miguel in San Miguel, California.
1950-1952	Served as a missionary at St. Thomas Yuma Mission in Fort Yuma, California

1952-1955	Served as a missionary at San Carlos Apache Mission in San Carlos Arizona.
1967	Died at Old Mission Santa Barbara in Santa Barbara, California. Buried at the Tohono O'odham reservation in Topawa, Arizona.

## Scope and Content Note

The papers of Bonaventure Oblasser, ofm (born 1885) extend from 1872-1982, with the bulk of the material concentrated in the period 1910-1939. A Franciscan Missionary pioneer, Oblasser was a Franciscan priest who spent much of his religious life among the Tohono O'odham (Papago) Indians in Arizona. The bulk of the written correspondence concerns Oblasser's efforts to raise funds for the construction of Catholic schools, securing teachers for these schools, as well as helping the Tohono O'odham negotiate water, land, and mineral rights with the United States government. The papers consist of correspondence, notes, clippings, scrapbooks, pamphlets, periodicals, books, maps and charts, pictures and photographs.

Correspondents in the collection include politicians Carl T. Hayden, George W.P. Hunt, Henry Ashhurst; government officials of the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs such as Charles Burke and John Collier; leaders of Order of Friars Minor and fellow missionaries in the field; support agencies for the missions such as the Bureau of Catholic Indian Missions, the Marquette League for Indian Welfare, and other private donors; scholars Herbert Bolton, Frank Lockwood, and others; and former students and friends.
