Series 7 Contains news-clippings and partial tear-sheets in scrapbooks.

FS01-S7 and FS02-S7

Individually housed scrapbooks were created to collect articles and illustrations of vessels built by a variety of shipbuilders; news clippings are from a variety of sources.

The front cover of a scrapbook entitled "Magazine Designs", is hand-painted in white on black ground, cloth-cover. The scrapbook has been laid out in sections to display vessels by overall length: 15-25 feet, 25 -30, 30-35, 35-40, 40-45, 45-50, 50-55, 55-60, 60-65, and 65 and up. Some sections are blank, most sections have incomplete paste-downs of cut-out illustrations. Most illustrations are line drawings from Pacific Motor Boat magazine. This scrapbook might have had use as a reference collection for design ideas.

The news clipping scrapbook is incomplete and bears clippings from articles dated in early 1920s.
