## Biographical Note

Marcus E. Jones (1852-1934) was a botanist who collected and described plants across the western United States and Mexico during the late 19th and early 20th centuries. He was born in Ohio and attended Grinnell College (at the time Iowa College). In the late 1870s, he made his first botanical collecting trips to the western United States and settled in Salt Lake City in 1880 with his wife Anna Richardson, where they worked as teachers. Although he was not formally educated as a botanist, he went on to describe over 900 plant taxa over the course of his career. He wrote numerous works on botany, mining, and other subjects, including his self-published journal, *Contributions to Western Botany*, and *Revision to the North American Species of Astragalus* (1923).

After the death of his wife in 1915, Jones sold his herbarium and library to Pomona College and moved to Claremont, California in 1923, where he continued his travels and botanical work until his death in a car accident in 1934.

## Scope and Content of Collection

The collection consists of photographs, negatives, diaries, correspondence, published and unpublished manuscripts, and newspaper clippings collected by Jones, covering his work and travels from the 1870s until his death in 1934. Especially well-represented in the collection are photographs of plants and landscapes of the western United States and Mexico, as well as glass negatives of *Astragalus* specimens, a plant genus Jones studied extensively.

Series I consists of glass lantern slides used by Jones to illustrate his lectures on botany and geology, including images taken by Jones during his travels and pictures taken of other publications.

Series II contains black-and-white photographs, primarily of the landscapes and plants of the western United States.

Series III contains black-and-white acetate negatives of landscapes, plants, and herbarium specimens.

Series IV contains black-and-white glass negatives, including landscapes, plants, and herbarium specimens, especially of plants in the genus *Astragalus*.

Series V consists of photo albums organized by location and topic. Subjects include plant life, geological formations, and human activities across the western United States and northern Mexico.

Series VI includes Jones's diaries and compilations of notes on plants beginning in 1878.

Series VII consists of Jones's correspondence, chiefly with other botanists. Most correspondence is original but some are photocopies. Notable correspondents include Asa Gray, Sereno Watson, and George Engelmann.

Series VIII contains Jones's unpublished manuscripts, including "Trees and Shrubs of Utah," "Flora of Flathead Lake," and "Flora of the Great Plateau."

Series IX contains newspaper and journal articles by Jones, including an incomplete set of his self-published *Contributions to Western Botany*, floras of California, Arizona, Utah, and Colorado, and other articles on botany, mining, religion, and other subjects.

Series X includes pen-and-ink botanical illustrations by Clara Brooks and Miss Merrill for *Revision to the North American Species of Astragalus* (1923) and the unpublished "Flora of the Great Plateau."

Series XI consists of five oversize ledger books with newspaper and journal articles authored by Jones and others, including his first published works as a Grinnell College (Iowa College) student in 1874.

Series XII contains reprints of articles on botany, geology, and other topics. Authors include Francis Ramaley, M. L. Fernald, and B. L. Robinson.

Series XIII include minor publications by Jones, hand-drawn climate graphs of Salt Lake City, and biographical accounts and memoirs about Jones. The series also contains photographic supplies and his early-twentieth century lantern slide projector, materials assembled for a 2017 exhibition on Jones's life and career, and photocopied correspondence written between Jones and members of his family.
