San Francisco Theological Seminary-related MSS.: Fraser on the beginnings of SFTS and the move from San Francisco to San Anselmo; correspondence from William Anderson Scott to Fraser, 1870-1880; Fraser on the SFTS endowment; correspondence with SFTS Directors, 1872-1896, including David Jacks (1891) and William Ladd (1872-1896); SFTS student term papers about Fraser. Also includes information about Fraser's daughter, Julia (including correspondence with SFTS administration)
