Abstract

Photographer Richard Hewett spent over five decades capturing the essence of Los Angeles, covering subjects as wide-ranging as television productions, hospital staff, school children and animals both domestic and wild. As a photographer working for *Los Angeles Times*, *Life*, *Look*, *Argosy*, *Venture*, and *TV Guide*, Hewett's assignments chronicled the wide variety of recreational and working life in L.A., including movie and television actors, animal trainers, stuntmen, business executives, citrus grove workers, store clerks, veterinarians, restaurateurs, teachers, musicians, artists, hippies and dancers. Locations include Rodeo Drive, Hollywood, Central Market, Miracle Mile, Disneyland, Marineland, Long Beach, Downtown Los Angeles, the San Fernando Valley, and Central Receiving Hospital, which closed within months of his visit.

Biography/History

Richard Ridgley Hewett was born in 1929 in St. Paul, Minnesota and developed an interest in photography at an early age. When he turned thirteen, his father built a darkroom in the basement of their home, and at age sixteen, with his father's consent, he joined the United States Marine Corps. Upon his military discharge, Hewett made use of the G.I. bill to pursue a career in photography and enrolled in the Art Center College of Design in Pasadena. Following his graduation in 1952, he rented a guest house in Hollywood, and converted it into a darkroom and living space where by night he developed film for the popular nightclub *Ciro's*, and by day he shot photo stories to submit to various magazines. In 1954 he sold his first photograph to *Life Magazine*, and followed up with his pictorial essay of teenagers in a record store listening booth for *Life's* weekly "Speaking of Pictures" page. This put Hewett in demand as a lifestyle photojournalist, and steady work followed with the *Los Angeles Times* weekly supplement "*This Week*," and then *Look*, *Argosy*, and *Cosmopolitan* magazines. He also had a long-running relationship with *TV Guide*, working for them consistently from 1958 until 1986. Later in life Hewett focused mainly on photographing subjects for children's non-fiction books authored by his wife and collaborator Joan, and also Caroline Arnold. Hewett passed away in 2006.

Scope and Content

The Collection contains over 75,000 color and black and white frames of negatives, color slides, and prints in 120, 35mm and 4x5 formats. The earliest examples of his work are his color transparencies taken of the Art Center School's Art Students Ball in 1952, with some featuring experimental solarizing techniques. His work for *TV Guide*, dating back to 1958, is his most prolific, featuring television actors in their homes and extensive coverage of productions on set, including table reads, lunch breaks, costume fittings, rehearsals and backstage pranks with cast and crew. Stories for other publications capture performances of concerts and plays, art exhibits, and recreational activities such as waterskiing, snowmobiling, parachuting, sailing, scuba diving and horseback riding. Post-war population growth and societal changes are depicted with photos of suburban

development, swimming pool installations, party food preparation and a visit inside a family's new bomb shelter. Animals are also a popular topic, including a cat who lives in an elementary school classroom; dogs on shopping trips; pet seals, goats, frogs and foxes; and a menagerie of professional animal actors. These lighthearted assignments for popular magazines are contrasted by intimate glimpses of doctors and nurses caring for patients, performing surgeries and the daily routine of a hospital, used in brochures and annual reports. Collaborations with his wife Joan for various children's book projects round out the Collection, covering zoology, earth science and careers in politics, law, music and acting.

Organization and Arrangement

The Collection is arranged into 8 series:

Series 1: Human Interest, which includes people engaged in recreational activities, cultural activities, work, domestic life, and hobbies.

Series 2: Entertainment Industry, which includes professional actors, directors, production crews, animal trainers, movie studios, television studios, location sets and promotional shoots.

Series 3: Children, at home, at school, swimming, horseback riding, interacting with their pets.

Series 4: Industries, including business executives in their offices, and in factory workers in manufacturing plants.

Series 5: Hospitals, showing actual surgeries as well as daily life in the patient rooms, administrative offices and various other departments.

Series 6: Los Angeles Landmarks, which includes recognizable locations in the city, such as Wilshire Blvd., Hollywood Freeway, and landmark buildings such as the Jonathan Club.

Series 7: Book Projects of both published and unpublished ideas for children's books.

Series 8: Animals/Nature, includes photo assignments and book projects involving trained animals, zoo animals, visits to Marineland and wildlife sanctuaries.

Many of the negatives and slides arrived mixed in with other subjects needing organization, and photo stories that were separated had to be pieced back together. Therefore, the negatives and slides are stored in the order they were assembled, yet within their respective Series, and are arranged by format. The film materials are followed by Internal Documentation, Publications, and Photographic Prints. Included in

the Collection are publications containing Richard Hewett's photos. The issues of *TV Guide* are stored in the cabinet drawer (HEWETT_f125 – HEWETT_f133). The oversized publications continue in boxes on top of the cabinet (HEWETT_b006 – HEWETT_b008). Photographic prints are also contained in boxes on top of the cabinet (HEWETT_b001 – HEWETT_b005).

Items Removed from the Collection
