#### Oversize Box 1

Includes photographs of critical resistance conferences, civil disobedience, anti-war marches, including arrest (2003), various photographs of Vito Russo, and other figures from Shaw's life. There is also a collection of personal photographs, including family reunions and international trips.

#### Oversize Box 2

Includes photographs of involvement in various demonstrations including Gulf war and Dan White demonstration (1982) along with photographs of the Los Angeles Riots (1992) . Photographs of AIDS activism including participation in the AIDS Conference of 1992 and Women Resisting AIDS Book launch. Photographs of various national Queer events including Dyke March and the 25th Anniversary of Stonewall in New York. Early 1980's tenure-seeking era photographs included along with personal photographs of travel, family, partners and friends.

#### Oversize Box 3

Includes photographs of Dyke March (1996, 2001), Gay Games (1998) along with Free Mumia demonstrations (1996). Personal photographs of various trips (including South Africa and Israel) included along with photographs of family, friends, and graduations.

#### Carton 19:

Includes t-shirts of Nancy Shaw Defense Fund, Gay Games (Zimbabwe & Amsterdam), Dyke March of 1996, CAL-PEP (California Prostitutes Education Project, Friends of the Pink Triangle, San Francisco Aids Foundation, and Critical Resistance. Also includes a hand sewn Earth Flag and a 1980 commemorative scarf of Zimbabwe's first prime minister Robert Gabriel Mugabe.

#### Carton 20:

Includes slides of the project "I Could Die Here" about the Santa Cruz Women Prisoners' Support Group (1985) as well as UCSC Course 'Sexuality and Revolution in China (1976). Slide Scripts are also included. There are five cartridges of slides of projects about incarcerated women involving women's health and prison conditions in Rikers Island Prison and in Santa Cruz. There are four cassette tapes, three of which are projects involving incarcerated women in Santa Cruz, California and Alderson, West Virginia and one VHS tape of an HIV/AIDS Outreach Project involving NAACP and DuPont Pharmaceuticals Co.

#### Carton 21:

Includes diaries, dream journals and memo books spanning 1957-1997. Letters, notes and postcards from 1956- 2015 including correspondence with lover, Catherine Tourette-Turgis from 1995-1997. There medals are included including one Gay Games Silver Medal from the Amsterdam Gay Games in 1998. There are personal photographs of marches and advocacy work as well as a 1958 girl scouts troop and camp along with negatives. There is a small box of

political pins including Act-Up, occupy, election campaigns, UC Santa Cruz pins among others and a 1986 SF Aids Foundation Safe-Sex Practices Condom.

Carton 22:

Includes various posters of Good Vibrations (2001), a farm workers labor advocacy, and art events in Santa Cruz including a Nancy Shaw Defense Benefit Blues concert (1989), and Gay & Lesbian artshow. Video materials include a vhs of Ruth Richman's 80th Birthday, two cassette tapes of interviews about lesbian Grandmotherhood and a Pornographic dvd starring Trans male porn star Billy Castro along with a 16mm home film reel (1978). Photographs include self-portraits, family photographs, and Kresge College. Texts include a UCSC Community Studies reader, Cervical Cancer Reports, Heresies Issue #15 (1982), Legal Services for Prisoners with Children (LSPC) pamphlet, Gay Freedom Day Program Copies and New Woman's Survival Catalog (1973). Also includes journal of gay Games attendance along with Gay Games badge(1998-1999) and various correspondence including a letter from Trans Man Frank Simpson on early phalloplasty surgeries, and his experience transitioning and letters with lover Nina Fortin.

Carton 23:

Majority is VHS's including National Aids projects (Cal-Pep, Hawaii AIDS group, NYC AIDS media & Empowerment Workshop), and a report on protease inhibitors. Commercial movies include City Heat, Bedroom Eyes, Lesbian erotic films including BurLEZK II, and political and activist projects including Santa Cruz Women's Health Center, a report from the Southern Poverty Law Center on a lawsuit against the Ku Klux Klan, "Serving in Silence: The Margarethe Cammermeyer Story", and a sexual harassment video about Andrea Nadel. VHS's concerning Universities include Gender Bias on the California Campus from AAUW, and UCSC Gay Awareness week 1990 and a student final project, "Young Warriors Resisting the War on Youth". Papers include book reviews of Lessons from the Damned: Queers, Whores, and Junkies Respond to AIDS, a list of books about HIV/AIDS (1995), Jan 1998 issue of The Advocate, SWS Network newsletter for Sociologists, Legal marriage documents, a visa for Hong Kong, and correspondence including a multiple letters from Leslie Van Houten and trans man Frank Simpson. Photographs include portraits, family photographs and prison research.

Carton 27:

Includes various negatives including San Francisco Dyke March (2001), 25th Anniversary of Stonewall and gay pride parade (1994), Women's health in prison negatives as well as photographs of prisons and prison conferences. Remaining slides of "I Could Die Here" about the Santa Cruz Women Prisoners' Support Group (1985) and various personal slides of travels, Gwendolyn Shaw, and family homes. Other personal photographs included in two family albums as well as travel including those taken by Donald Shaw with negatives from 1965-1972. Backup CD's of various files as well as gay awareness week (UCSC) and Impact, an animation film of

stories by family members of prisoners on death row by Dee Hibbert- Jones and Nomu Talisman.

Carton 28:

Kept in Original Order

Includes 5 travel notebooks with drawings, 2 of which are in Israel and Palestine. One dream/night thoughts journal and an unopened queer pornography dvd. Folders include Civil Rights Activism and involvement with the SNCC (The Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee) in the mid 1960's, Israeli-Palestinian Conflict work including involvement with the APHA (American Public Health Association) Joint Policy Committee on Improved Palesitnian Helath in Gaza. "Letter from the Damned" book reviews, publishing contract. Drafts of work on depression and moral guilt from mid 1960's to early 19990's. Folders pertaining to UCSC include merit reviews, salary information, business cards, and student papers. "Life and Health in Women's Prisons- a Twenty Year Retrospective" project folders include Bureau of Prisons correspondence, project research, Prison Social Climate Survey (Inmates and correctional medical staff), and an overview of BOP Federal Medical Center, Campbell Overview.

Carton 29:

A/V includes HIV/AIDS vhs 'Coming to Life' Video Outreach from NAACP-DuPont pharmaceuticals and 'Clean, Sober and Positive- Recovery and living with HIV' vhs. VHS pertaining to cancer include Leo Chavez' 'Latina's perceptions of Breast and Cervical Cancer' and Santa Cruz Women's Health Center guide to Breast Health. Annie Sprinkle's DVDs include 'Herstory of Porn' and 'Amazing World of Orgasm'. Other sex realted VHS's include 'How to Female Ejacuate', 'Blood Sisters' (about S/M), 'Viva La Vulva- Women's Sex Organs Revealed'. Multiple CD's include interviews with Nancy Stoller about her work with SNCC along with a SNCC documentary DVD. VHS's pertaining to prison include 'Organizing Women in Prison' and a documentary on the legacy of three strikes. Teaching VHS include Nancy Stoller's inaugural lecture as well as two debates from Community Studies courses, and "Not a gentleman but a scholar" (1989) and "Teacher, Teacher" (1991). VHS on Proposition 21&22 along with a Feinstein fundraiser. Also includes a VHS labeled Queer Pride Interviews. One folder includes correspondence on tapes and a color key for cassettes not included in carton.

Carton 30:

Carton includes one album of family photographs, one notebook about a trip to South Africa; the rest of the carton are folders involving Women's prisons including articles written by Nancy Stoller about Women's health in prisons, Standards for Health Care for Jails and Prisons, Nancy Stoller involvement in the Bay Area Prison Health Group and a shadow commission involving future prison closures for Californians United for A Responsible Budget (CURB). Carton also includes materials on the 'Nancy Shaw Legal Defense Fund' including fundraising, contacts, legal documents, and articles found in Santa Cruz periodicals. Other UCSC documents involve personnel merit reviews (1998, 200-2001, 2003-2004), Nancy Stoller's retirement party from the University in 2007. Carton includes various correspondence with intimate partners, friends notably, Leslie Van Houten and Irena Klepfisz.
