## Hart, Jerome A., 1854-1937

#### **Historical Note:**

Known as a pioneer in writing and literature to the West, Jerome Hart brought the field to new dimensions. He was born Sept. 6, 1854 into a prominent New Jersey family. Hart's grandfather, Abraham Clark, was a signer of the Declaration of Independence. His journey westward would bring him to San Jose, CA. where he met and later married Ann Clark, member of a famous San Francisco family. Relocation to San Francisco saw Hart's employment at the *Examiner* and then the *Argonaut*. Editor and major stockholder there he remained for 37 years. Under his tutelage the *Argonaut* became known throughout its home city of San Francisco, nationwide, and in foreign lands. The writings of Jerome Hart were descriptive of the times and places in which he lived. His travels of the world were captured in "Two Argonauts in Spain" and his "Argonaut Letters." Life of the West found daily description or criticism in the Argonaut or in books such as "A Vigilante Girl" and "In our Second Century." His ability to spot merit in different types of literary workmen marked his greatness as an editor and writer alike. Among those talents he discovered were Jack London and S.E. White.

Hart was a member of many local intellectual clubs and organizations. The Bohemian Club saw him in 1882 its Secretary and 1883 its Vice-President. Apart from his participation in the organized events Hart was instrumental in locating the site for the Bohemian Grove in Sonoma. Copies of his authored books and those from his collections were frequently donated to the club.

Investigation, research, and organization were not only foundations of his writings, but necessities in his life. All books that he read were logged and critiqued. These critiques along with all bills, letters, clippings, manuscripts, or other material that may have been of some importance were saved and filed within an extensive system. Hart died on Jan. 3, 1937.

Mrs. Hart, also a writer, would author many articles and books including one in honor of her father, William S. Clark, entitled "Battle of Santa Clara." After Jerome Hart's death Mrs. Hart continued to be a fixture in San Francisco society by being a holder of great amounts of property and taking up the struggle to preserve the city's cemeteries.

## **Scope and Content:**

The folders of Jerome A. Hart consist of his collected papers that once were held in his private files. Materials such as correspondence, bills, manuscripts, ephemera, etc. Within the volumes are clippings of Hart's work from the *Argonaut*, clippings of other authors, and memorabilia. Boxes of the second series contain the files of Mrs. Hart containing mainly correspondence, bills, memorabilia, and some of her manuscripts.
